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	What is BUFDG?		
	The British Universities Finance Directors Group (BUFDG) is the representative body for higher education finance staff in the United Kingdom. Our members are the Directors of Finance and Chief Financial Officers of UK higher education institutions, and their staff. We are entirely owned by our member HE institutions and are not-for-profit.		
Our objectives	BUFDG has three primary objectives: To inform, guide, and support; To facilitate networking and development; and, To partner, coordinate, advocate, and influence.		
lt's for Everyone	Who can access BUFDG?		
Everyone	Any member of staff at your university is welcome to sign up for a website account. This provides access to all BUFDG services including financial resources, information, reports, news, the discussion boards, our e-learning suite, and all other learning & development.		
	Over 8,000 staff at UK universities currently benefit from BUFDG access. These are mostly from within finance teams or other finance or procurement roles across the university, but also include staff from a wide variety of roles covering areas such as planning, facilities, HR, governance, and beyond.

Our Cost	Applying for Membership Fees for access to BUFDG are charged annually and are based on the turnover of the member institution.				
	The subscription year for BUFDG runs from 1 st August to 31 st July. If your institution is joining on or after the 1 st February, then 60% of the subscription is due. There are two levels of membership - a standard level, and BUFDG Pro (which includes our extensive and expanding <u>suite of e-learning modules</u>). Membership is at an institution-level, which means that a single membership fee includes the above benefits for any members of staff at the HEI, with no upper limit on numbers.

Walking Lastly... What is PHES?

Professional HE Services Ltd (PHES) is a limited company owned by UK universities. It provides an operating framework for membership organisations that support the HE sector, known as Special Interest Organisations (SIOs). PHES enables SIOs to share staff and other resources, and to operate effectively and efficiently.

There are currently seven SIOs under the PHES 'umbrella', of which BUFDG is just one. The others are the Association of University Directors of Estates (AUDE), the Higher Education Strategic Planners Association (HESPA), Universities Human Resources (UHR), the Council of Higher Education Internal Auditors (CHEIA), the Association of University Legal Practitioners (AULP), and College and University Business Officers (CUBO).

Each organisation has its own structure and terms of reference and is run by its own executive. Please let us know in your application if you would like to also consider membership of other PHES organisations. <u>Find out more about PHES here</u>.
